Requirements for Youth Sailing Program Parents of the Day

The Parent of the Day is a primary resource to the Head Instructor and a safety asset to the program. The Parent of the Day must be present on the Club grounds during the period of instruction from 8:45 AM until 4:15 PM at a designated location in or immediately outside of the clubhouse. You may be provided with, and instructed in the use of, a personal (non-VHF) radio for contact with the instructors and Member of the Day.

The Parent of the Day will:

1. Locate and understand the operation of the Club telephone and procedure for calling emergency services.
2. Monitor the Club VHF radio, tuned as instructed by the Head Instructor, and will be knowledgeable in basic VHF transmission protocols.
3. Assist with such activities as maintaining the attendance roster, lunch supervision, operation of the snack bar, attending to children who drop from the instructional program.
4. Contact parents of students who become ill or who need parental attention or supervision.
5. Consult with the Member of the Day as required.

The Parent of the Day will be provided with a roster and contact information for all parents and key Club officers and will contact these persons when necessary.

The Parent of the Day may bring other family members or friends provided they are not deemed by the Head Instructor or Director of Sailing Education Programs to interfere with the program. The Parent of the Day should advise the Head Instructor or Director in advance of his or her intention to bring other family members along.

The Parent of the Day will defer to the Head Instructor in matters of instruction and program management.
